CARRIAGE OF EARTHMOVING AND EQUIPMENT ATTACHMENTS

Dear Valued Customer,

Sea Swift has implemented the following in relation to the carriage of earthmoving and equipment attachments within large buckets.

Sea Swift will no longer accept any machinery for transport that has earthmoving and equipment attachments unsecured within large buckets.

All earthmoving and equipment attachments transported within large buckets must be secured for loading, shipping and unloading prior to entering Sea Swift's premises.

The preferred method of securing items is by chaining, as shown in Figures 2 and 3 below.

RIGHT TO REFUSE UNSECURED FREIGHT

Sea Swift reserves the right to refuse unsecured freight for transport, or to secure the freight with Sea Swift's time and cost passed onto the customer.

Other items of cargo should either be shipped separately or secured adequately within the bucket to ensure there is no risk of the item becoming dislodged during loading, shipping or unloading of the equipment.
